

Rs. 10 lakh per village for Dang region

JAIPUR: The newly-established Dang Area Development Board plans to allocate Rs.10 lakh each for the villages in Bharatpur and other eastern Rajasthan districts for their all-round development after formulating new action plans for them.

According to Board chairman Satyanarain Singh, comprehensive lists of works in

each village panchayat would be sent to the State Government and efforts made to link the execution of works with the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Guarantee Scheme to ensure their early completion.

Mr. Singh visited Bayana and Rupbas panchayat samitis in Bharatpur district on Tuesday to interact with sarpanches, panchayat secretaries and other elected

representatives. He noted that the young persons rendered unemployed after the ban on mining in the region should be supported and trained in other sources of livelihood.

The State Government has sanctioned Rs.37.72 lakh for 14 village panchayats falling in the jurisdiction of Bayana and Rupbas panchayat samitis as part of the Dang area development programme.
