

## 'Most village road projects completed in Rajasthan'

**JAIPUR:** A total of 10,431 of the 10,850 projects sanctioned for connecting remote villages with roads of good quality in Rajasthan have been completed till September this year under the Prime Minister's Gram Sadak Yojana. These proposals were submitted by the State Government to the Centre.

Union Minister of State for Rural Development Pradeep Jain 'Aditya' said in Lok Sabha on Wednesday that the Union Government had provided Rs.3,523 crore to the State during the past three financial years and till October this year for implementing these projects. Of this amount, the State Government has so far spent Rs.3,349 crore.

According to an official release here, Mr. Jain said the implementation of the sanctioned projects was being monitored at regular intervals.

The Union Government would ensure that all projects under the PMGSY are executed effectively and on schedule and extend the intended benefits to the target groups, he said.
