Monthly summary for the month of September, 2019

(I) Mid Term Review (MTR) Meetings in respect of states namely, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Bihar and Karnataka were held under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (MGNREGA), Department of Rural Development from 17.9.2019 to 30.9.2019 with concerned Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary/ Secretary/Commissioner (In-charge of MGNREGA)/Directors (Social Audit) MGNREGA of the all the States/UTs.

(II) Against a total allocation of Rs.9024 crore for National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) in Budget Estimate 2019-20, the total amount released up to 30.09.2019 is Rs.4594.59 crore.

(III) Under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana (DAY)-NRLM, during the FY 2019-20 (up to 31.08.2019) about 422367 Self Help Groups (SHGs) were promoted covering 47.64 lakh households. An amount of Rs.146.12 crore was disbursed to 105016 SHGs as Revolving Fund (RF) and Rs.252.07 crore was disbursed to 39485 SHGs as Community Investment Fund (CIF).

(IV) (a) A workshop, to discuss the training structure and contents for the various stakeholder under National Rural Economic Transformation Project (NRETP) was organised on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at India Habitat Center (IHC) New Delhi. The officials from World Bank, Kudumbashree, EDII, ILO, Wadhvani Foundation participated in this workshop.

(b) Workshop for Supporting Rural Incubator – NRLM with “Start-up India” was organized on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at Vigyan Bhavan Annexe with various stakeholders to discuss the approaches for supporting rural incubators.

(c) A Community Resource Person (CRP) conclave was organized at BP PAL Auditorium, Pusa on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> of September, 2019. The conclave was chaired by the Secretary (RD). Pashu Sakhi, Krishi Sakhi, Van Sakhi, BC Sakhi, e-CRP from various states had participated.

(V) (a) Under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), upto September, 2019, a total of 1,50,428 eligible unconnected habitations (excluding LWE) were connected by constructing 6,04,453.527 kms rural roads and 16,086 habitations (excluding LWE) were connected by the States by their own resources. 3,563 habitations (excluding LWE) were dropped whereas 509 habitations are not feasible for providing connectivity. Besides, different States reported that 2407 habitations are not feasible as of now due to reasons such as forest clearance, land issues and court cases. The remaining 5,192 habitations are at different stages of completion.

(b) During the month of September, 2019, an amount of Rs.2597.425 crore was released to the States under PMGSY. The cumulative release up to the month of September, 2019 stands at Rs.3437.5100 crore.



(VI) (a) Under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), a team of officials of PMAY-G visited Barsat District Haryana on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2019 for Awaas + data field validation.

(b) A team of officials of PMAY-G visited Jalgaon District Maharashtra on 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2019 for field validation of Awaas + Data.

(c) A team of officials of PMAY-G visited Sant Kabeer Nagar District Uttar Pradesh on 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 for validation of Awaas + Data uploaded by the State.

(d) A regional workshop was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at Daman to discuss best practices in PMAY-G.

(e) A meeting of Expert Committee on Awaas + data headed by Dr. Nagesh Singh, Former Additional Secretary, RD was held on 24.09.2019 for discussion on finalization of Awaas + data.

(f) A meeting of Expert Committee for revisiting the definition of Kutcha houses under PMAY-G was held on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.

(VII) (a) An amount of Rs.9200.00 crore was allocated to National Social Assistance Program (NSAP) schemes for the financial year 2019-20. An amount of Rs.634.30 crore was released to the States/UTs in the month of September, 2019. An amount of Rs.3633.30 crore was released to the States/UTs under NSAP schemes upto September, 2019.

(b) The target set for DBT transactions for 2019-20 is 36 crore. A total of 8.12 crore DBT transactions were recorded till September, 2019 under NSAP scheme. DBT Mission code for National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) has been onboard on DBT Bharat Portal.

(c) Department emphasizing the issue of enrollment/collection of Aadhaar for NSAP beneficiaries and seeding same in the database of beneficiaries with their consent.

(VIII) (a) Under Deen Dayal Upadhyay Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), during the month of September, 2019 (as on 07.10.2019), a total of 10,522 candidates were trained and 14,495 candidates were placed as per Kaushal Pragati Portal. This includes candidates trained under Himayat Scheme also. In FY 2019-20 upto September, 2019, a total of 1,04,501 candidates were trained and 79,670 candidates were placed as per Kaushal Pragati Portal.

(b) Under Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETI), during the month of September, 2019, a total of 35,692 candidates were trained and 17,129 candidates were settled. In FY 2019-20 upto September, 2019, a total of 1,68,164 candidates were trained and 79,918 candidates were settled.

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
