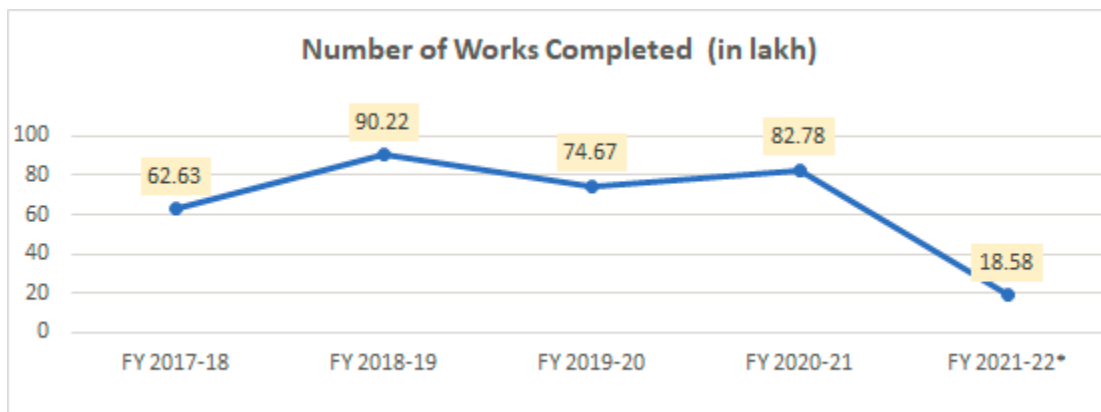
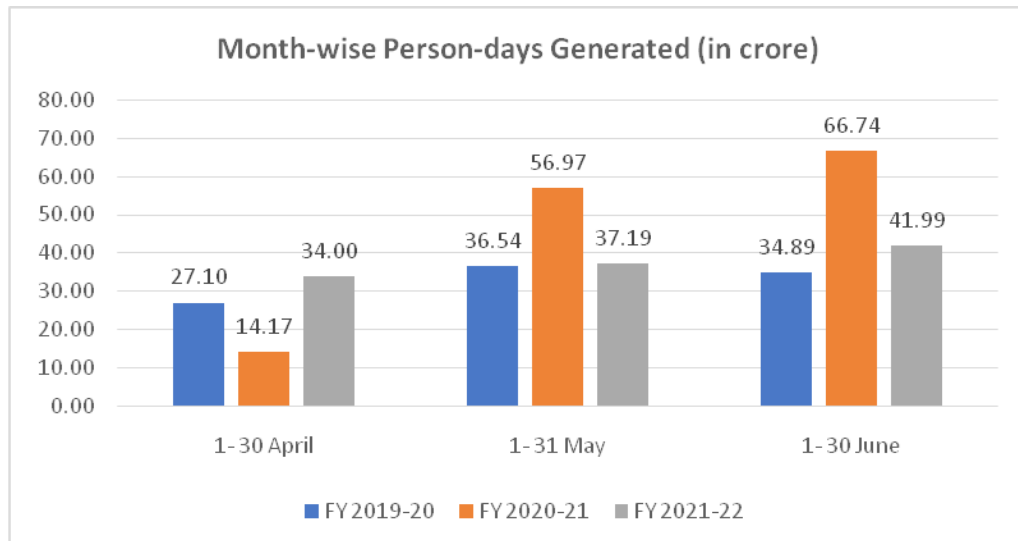

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

(i) Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act

Under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) 2.46 crore workers were offered employment daily on average basis in the month of June 2021 compared to 3.58 Crore in June 2020. Further, 41.99 crore person-days of work was generated during the month of June 2021 as against 66.74 crore in the corresponding month of previous year. In the FY 2021-22, against a BE of Rs.73,000 Crore, 36,522.85 Cr has been released as on 30.06.2021, for providing employment to 3.84 Crore householdsthereby generating 99.56 Cr person days of work. Also, during the current FY, around 53% of employment have been generated for women and 37% for SCs & STs. This Act has ensured financial inclusion of around 13.01 crore active workers of Mahatma Gandhi NREGA scheme having their active saving accounts in Banks and Post Offices.

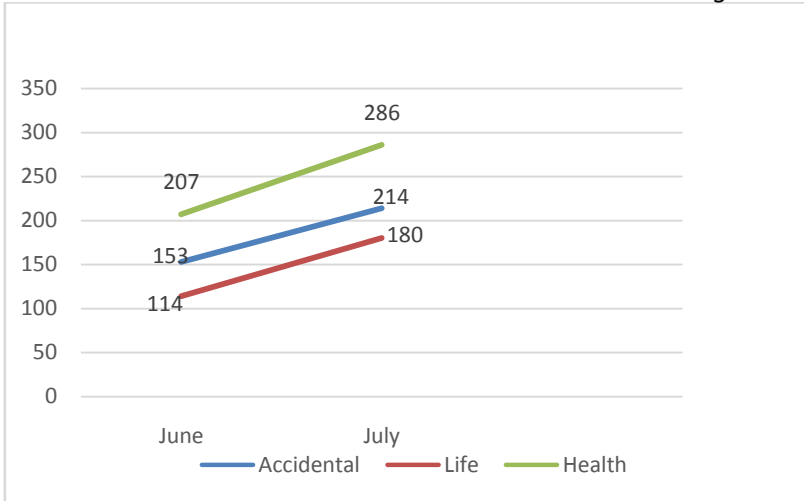

(ii) Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana (DAY-NRLM)

a) Under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana (DAY-NRLM), against a total allocation of Rs.13,677.61 crore for FY 2021-22, a total of Rs.1972.08 crore has been released upto 30.06.2021. During this year, 3352 village organizations (VO) and 360 Cluster Level Federations (CLF) have been promoted making a cumulative number of 4,04,786 VOs and 30,709 CLFs.

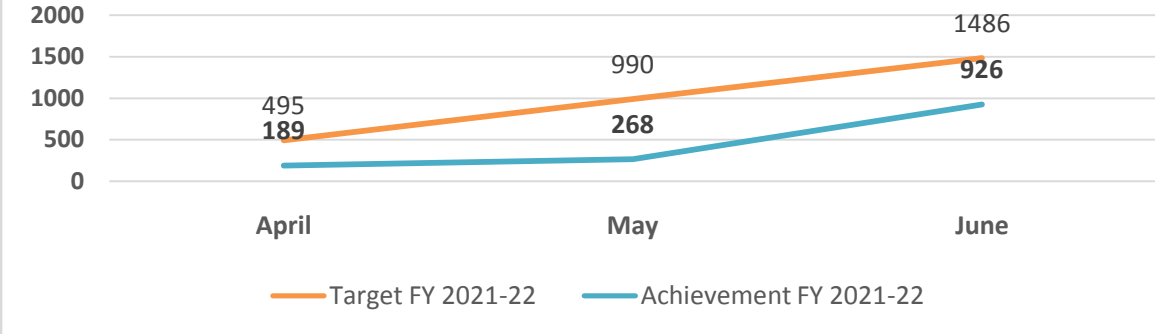

(iii) Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)

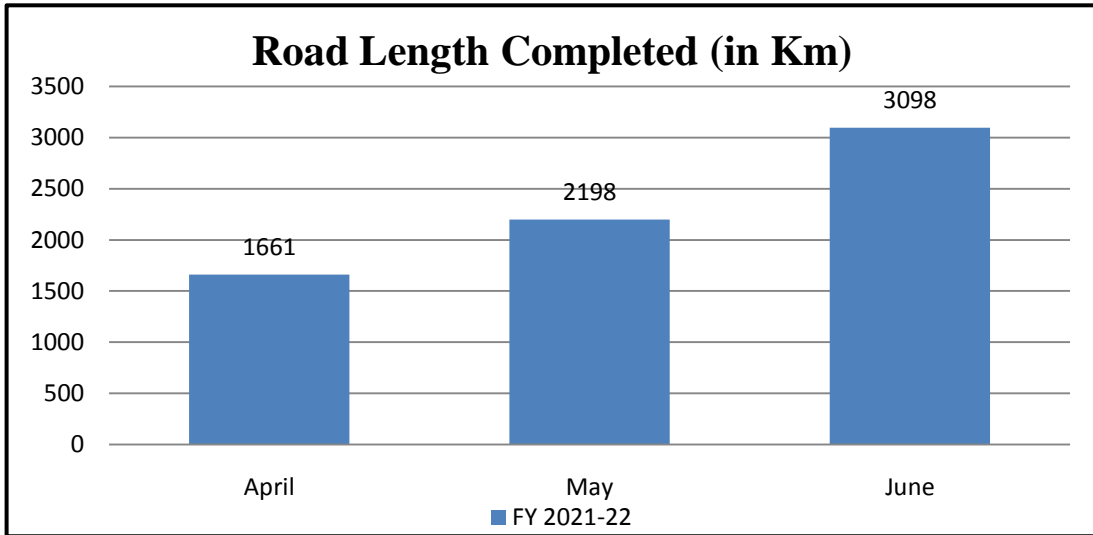
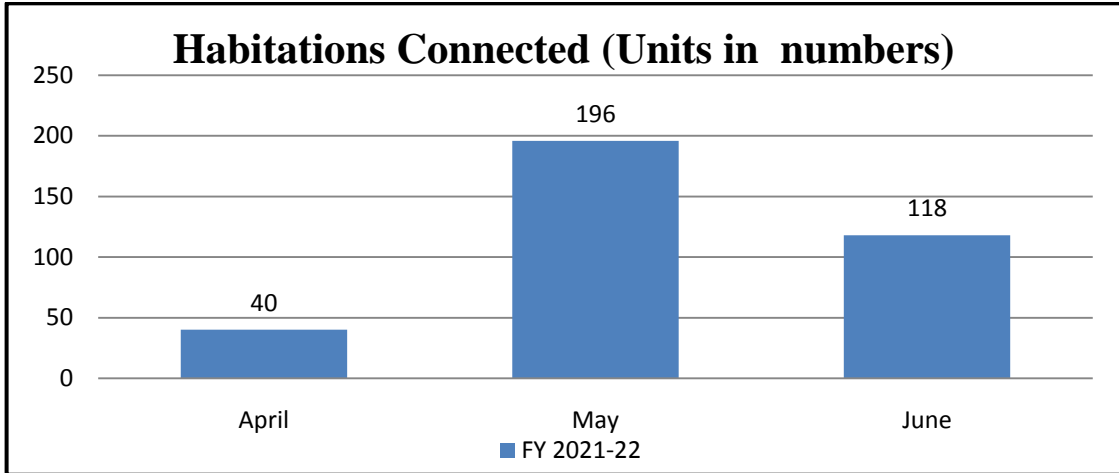
- a) Under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), against 1,78,184 eligible habitations of 250+ and 500+ population size identified for coverage under the scheme, 16,086 habitations have been provided connectivity by the States out of their own resources and 4,699 habitations have either been dropped or have not been found feasible. Out of the balance 1,57,399 habitations sanctioned for providing connectivity under the PMGSY, 1,55,241 have already been covered till 30th June, 2021. Thus, as on 30th June, 2021, 2,158 habitations remain to be saturated. Under 100-249 population category (LWE areas), 6,542 habitations were sanctioned for connectivity, out of which 5,777 habitations have been saturated till 30th June, 2021 and 509 remain to be saturated. A total of 7,67,969 km road length has been sanctioned and **6,69,643** km constructed till 30th June, 2021 under various interventions/verticals of scheme as detailed below.

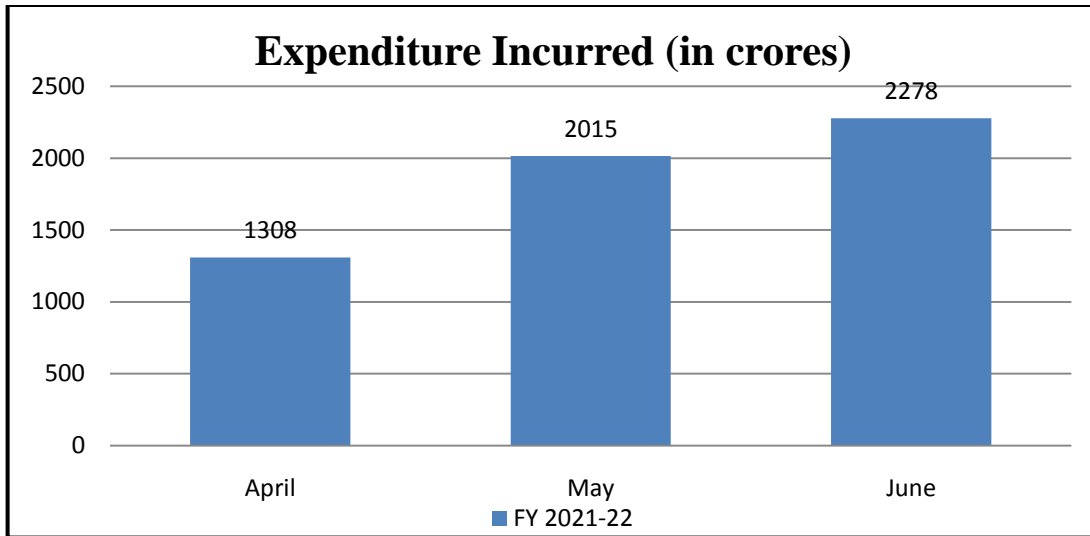

(iv) Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin

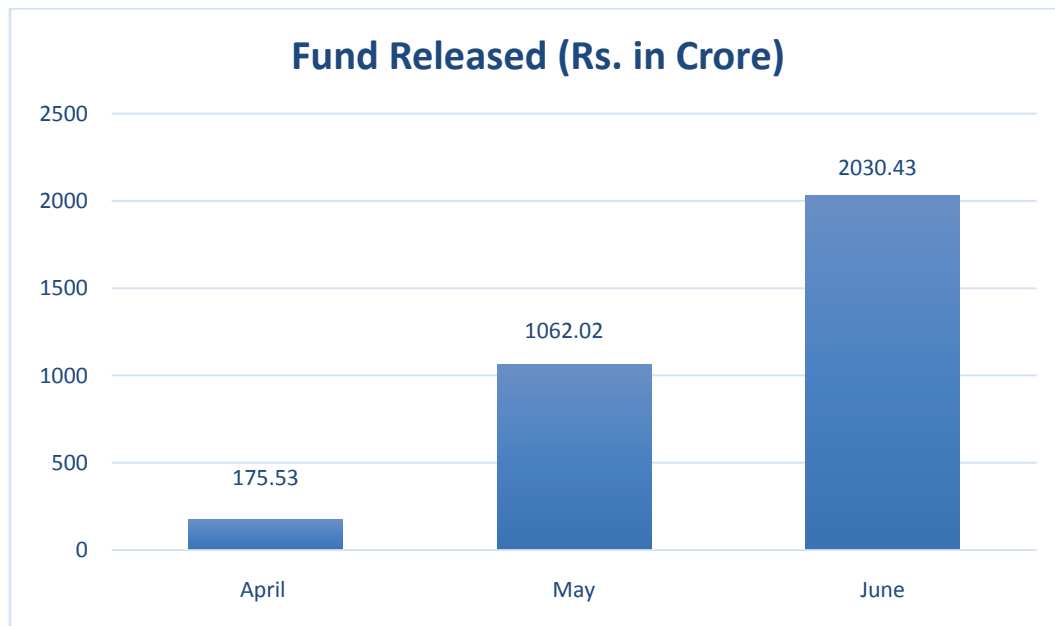
- a) Under the PMAY-G, against a BE of 19,500 Crore for the F.Y 2021-22, an amount of 3268.02 Crore has been released upto 30.06.2021 including an amount of Rs.2030.43 Crore released during the month of June, 2021. A total of 190.777 lakh houses have been completed as on 30th June, 2021.

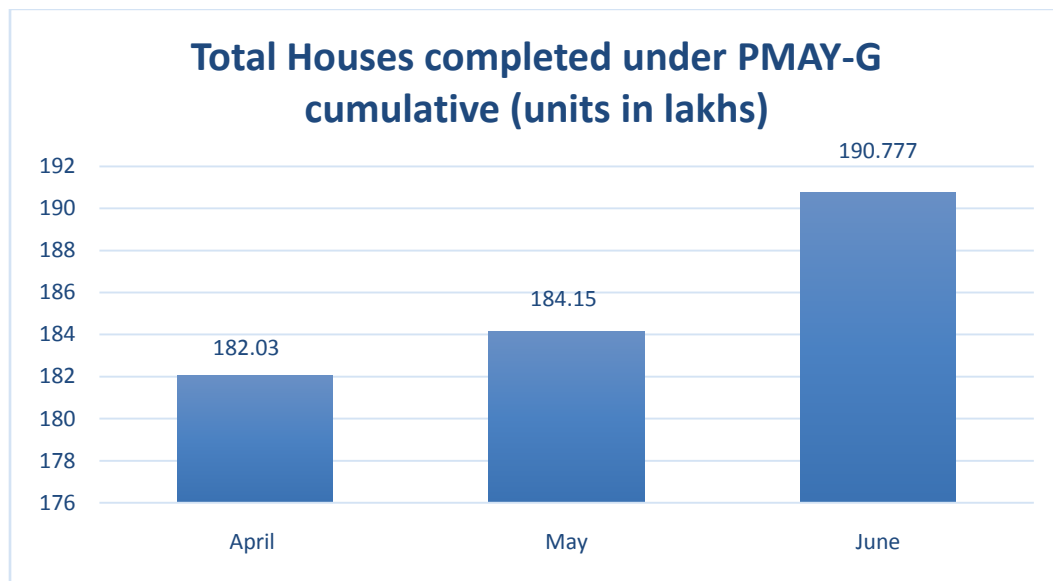
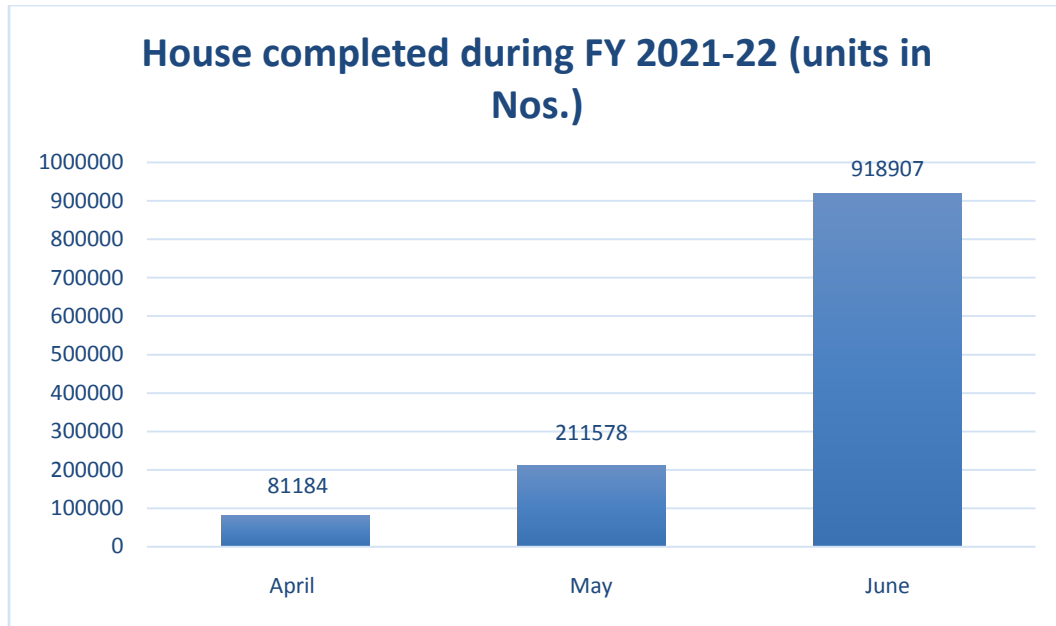

(v) National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP)

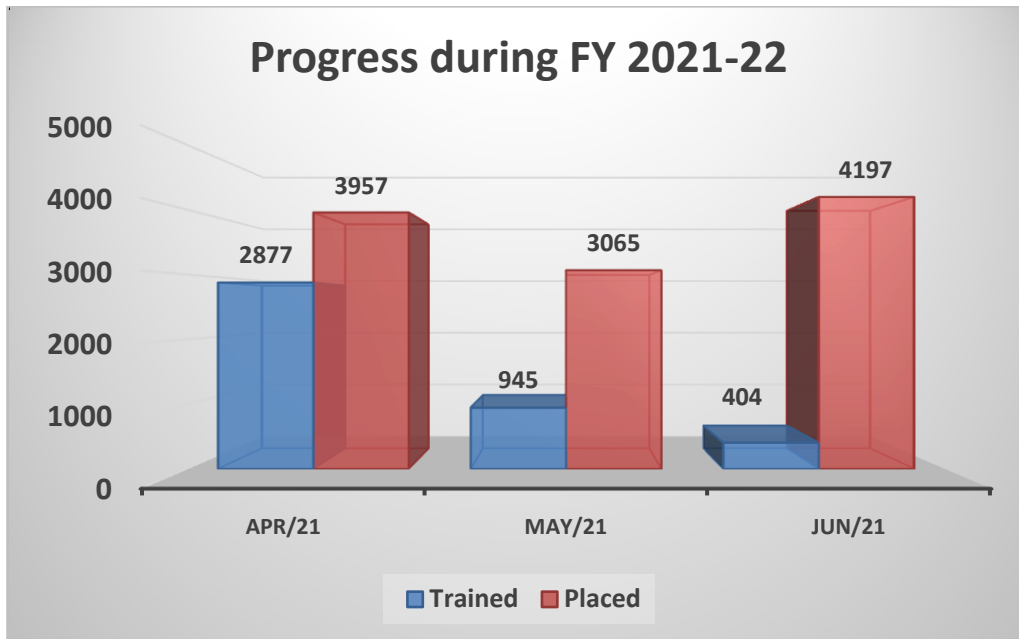
Under NSAP, out of Rs. 9,200 crore allocated for the FY 2021-22, an amount of Rs.962.08 crore has been released to the states/UTs till June, 2021 including an amount of Rs.648.58 Crore released during the month of June 2021. While 20.39 crore DBT transactions were recorded in the FY 2020-21, a total of 3.08 crore DBT transactions have been reported by the states in the current FY upto the month of June 2021.

(vi) DeenDayal Upadhyaya GraminKaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY)

a) Under the DDU-GKY, during FY 2021-22, 2482 Candidates have been trained and 10886 candidates placed upto June 2021 including 24 candidates trained and 4031 candidates placed during the month of June 2021, which is inclusive of candidates trained under Himayat Schemes. Similarly, under RSETI programme, a total of 13584 candidates have been trained and 19636 candidates settled upto June 2021 inclusive of 2530 candidates trained and 9150 candidates settled during the month of June 2021.

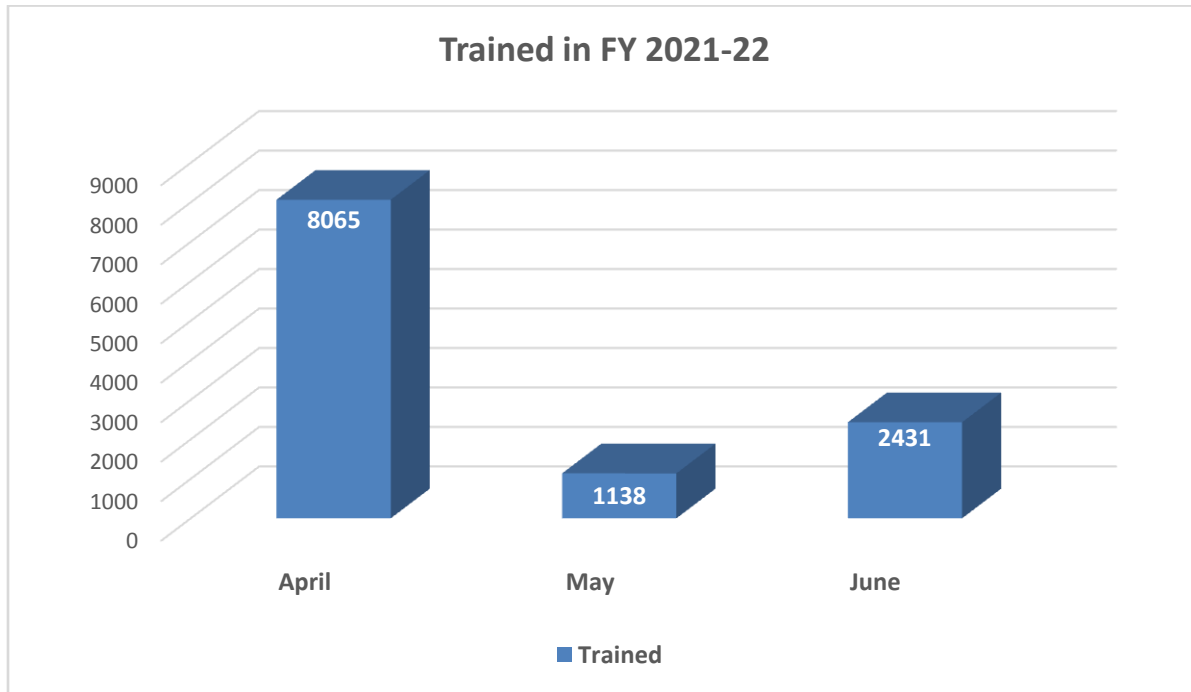
(c) **RSETIs**

Under RSETIs, in the financial year 2021-22 up-to June, 2021 a total of 13584 candidates have been trained and 19636 have been settled and in the month of June, 2021 itself a total of 2530 candidates have been trained and 9150 candidates have been settled. The training activity has been impacted due to second wave of Covid19.

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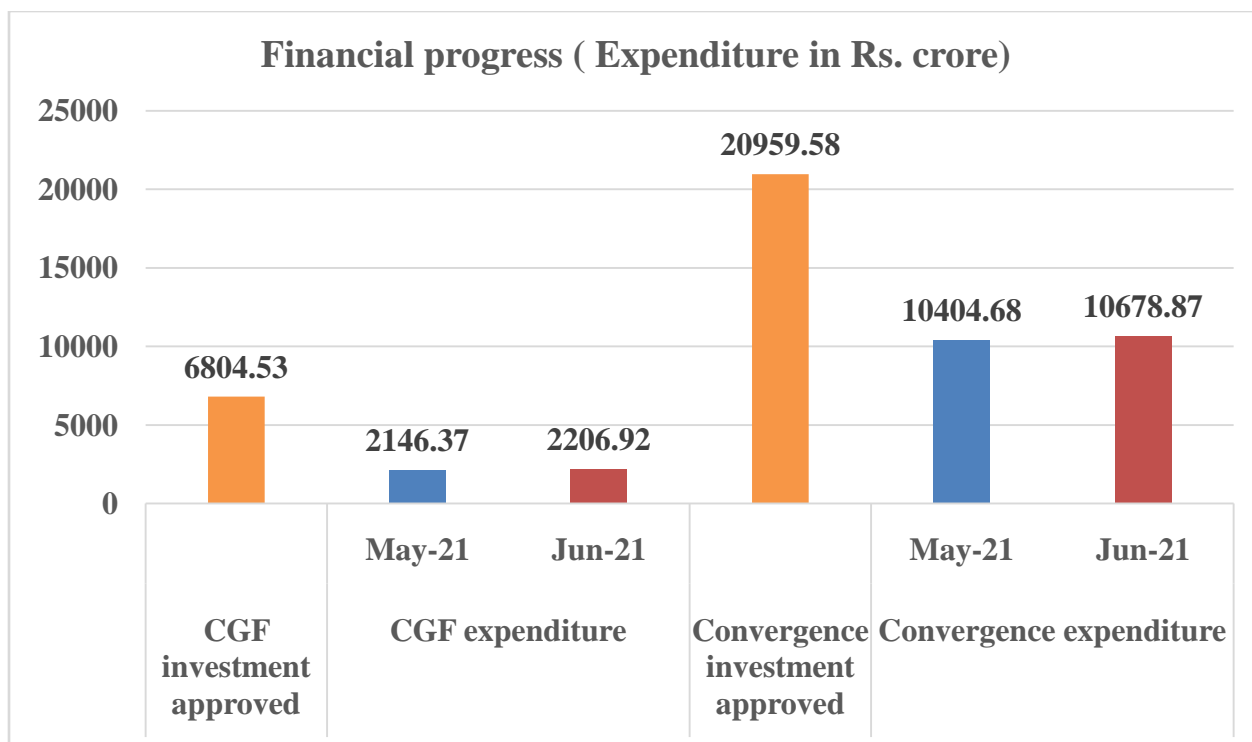

(vii) Spatial Planning of the clusters under Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rural Mission

Under Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rural Mission (SPMRM), with the relaxation of lockdown restrictions in some States and UTs, gradual progress has been observed with a reported expenditure of Rs.60.55 crore under CGF and Rs.274.19 crore under convergence.
